All students are required to maintain an @sulross.edu computer email account. This account provides both an online identification key and a university official e-mail address. Such correspondence is mailed only to the university official e-mail address.

Non-Payment of Tuition And Fees

Students who have not paid at least one-half tuition and fees (or made confirmed arrangements through Financial Assistance) by the 12th class day (4th class day in summer sessions) will be dropped from all classes. Efforts will be made to notify students who are scheduled to be dropped by campus e-mail and phone. In order to be reinstated back into class you must pay an additional \$100 reinstatement fee. Anyone who has not resolved tuition and fee payment by the 20th class day (15th class day in summer sessions) will not be allowed to be re-instated in class.
